REGISTRATION

Check-in will take place in the Ballroom
Foyer - check the event schedule for exact
times. Upon check-in you will receive your
wristband(s), audition number(s) and
additional workshop information. Dancers
registered with a studio DO NOT need to
individually check-in at the hospitality booth
if the studio has more than 10 dancers
attending the event. Teachers/studio
representatives will pick up the registration
materials for all dancers in their group.
Dancers will need their wristbands to attend
open classes on Friday. Feel free to register
for any event add on pending availability i.e.
stage workshop, improv competition, etc.

WRISTBANDS

Each dancer, teacher, studio representative, and observers will receive an ADE wristband that must be worn at all times during the event. Individuals not wearing the correct wristband will not be permitted to enter

the ballrooms. Wristbands cannot be transferred, and if lost, full payment is required to receive a new band, NO EXCEPTIONS!

OBSERVERS

Guests wishing to view workshop classes may purchase an Observer wristband prior to the event, or from the Merchandise Booth at any time during the event. Observers may not dance or take notes during class.

Parents Class: We invite you to take the ADE parent class! You must be a registered observer to participate in the parent class.

How It Works:

- Each studio choreographer has the opportunity to select up to 3 routines to be considered. There is NO extra fee to participate in this program.
- At each regional competition, the judges will select 1 finalist routines that display exceptional choreographic quality and will be invited to our Nationals in Orlando, FL.
- There is no maximum of routines selected in a certain age group, genre, or category.

What Happens Next:

At Nationals, the TOP 1 routine, and finalist choreographer will be invited to one of our tour cities to CHOREOGRAPH a routine on our Prodigy All-Stars and TEACH an Open Class at one of our events!

STUDIO OF THE YEAR AWARD \$10,000 PRIZE


4,000 Cash Prize + \$43,000 Regional Credit + \$3,000 Nationals Credit

(To be used during the 2025-2064 ADE Regionals)

The Studio of the Year Award is given to a studio that demonstrates excellence in dance education throughout a variety of dance styles, levels and age divisions.

In order to be eligible for Studio Of The Year, studios must register at least 20 routines at our Season Finale.

- 9-10 Solos or Duets/Trios
- 10-12 Small (4-9 Dancers) or Large Group/Line= (10-21 Dancers) Group Routines or Productions.
